## Website Worksheet

• What Percentage of your available inventory is on your website

Total Available Inventory Units ÷ Units of Inventory on Your Website = % On your Website

**Example:** If your had 1,000 items available for sale in your store and you currently had 100 items on your website.

Total Available Inventory Units 1,000 ÷ 100 Units of Inventory on Your Website = 10% of your inventory is on your website

• What Percentage of your available inventory do you want on your website? (Knowing how much is currently there be realistic)

% = My Goal to have on my website

• How many items do you receive daily? This should be a average, so take a month for example August and report how many items you received for the month by the number of days you accept items.

Total Units of Inventory Received August \_\_\_\_\_ ÷ \_\_\_\_ Days You Accepted Items In August =

\_ Average Number of Items Received Per Day

**Example:** You receive 1,000 units a month and you accept items 20 days during the month you receive 50 items per day

Total Units Received  $1,000 \div 20$  Days of the month you accept items = 50 Items Received Per day on average.

• Daily Items to Add to Website to achieve your goal =

Average Items Received Per Day x % My Goal to Have on your website.

**Example**: If you receive 50 items per day and your goal is to have 15% of your inventory on your website.

50 Items Received Per Day x 15% Goal to have on your website =

7.5 items/day must be added to your website
